

**TOWN OF CHELSEA
PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES
February 12, 2014**

The Chelsea Board of Selectmen held a public hearing on Wednesday, February 12, 2014 at 6:00PM in the Chelsea Elementary School Cafeteria to invite comments and answer questions from residents regarding the granting of an easement to the cell tower lease located at 1045 Eastern Avenue in Chelsea.
