

**TOWN OF CHELSEA
PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES
General Assistance Ordinance
October 22, 2014**

The Chelsea Board of Selectmen held a public hearing on Wednesday, October 22, 2014 at 6:45PM at the Grange Hall.
